

Pranavi set for LET pre-qualifying event

With Covid-19 enforced lockdown playing spoilsort for major part of 2020, Indian golfer Pranavi Urs was eager to have a good 2021. Just two months into the year, and the athlete suffered a stress fracture in her right wrist. The girl from Mysuru could not even train with the injury keeping her out of action till May.

However, there is a spring in her step now after featuring in four domestic and two international competitions in the last couple of months. Pranavi has already set big goal for herself as she is set to compete at the Ladies European Tour pre-qualifying tournament in Spain, starting Thursday with the hope of getting a full card, which is not going to be easy.

She will compete in the event against 156 players, which is expected to be very competitive and 30 golfers are expected to make it to the second stage. The contest gets even more difficult in the final stage, which will comprise some more quality players.

“This is my ever qualifying event for the LET. I am taking it as another tournament, where I have to give my best. I am confident of doing well. I know it is not going to be easy with quality players from all around the world. Everybody will be playing to get the full tour card,” said Pranavi, who is also supported by Allcargo Logistics for next three years.
