

Allcargo International Supply Chain (ISC) Monthly Operational Update


Despite the continued volatility due to geopolitical disruptions, we witnessed a growth of 6.3% YoY in FCL, 4.4% YoY in Air and marginal 3.7% YoY de-growth in LCL business during May 2025.

LCL operations:

- LCL volume stood at 728'000 cubic meters for the month of May 2025 depicting a growth of 3% as compared to last month and a decline of 4% as compared to last year.
- Demand is expected to witness volatility due to trade tensions and uncertainties in the geopolitical landscape.
- LCL volume witnessed month on month increase in the regions of Latin America, Europe, Asia Pacific and Indian Sub-continent. A month-on-month decline was witnessed in USA, Canada and Middle East. As compared to last year volumes increased in the regions of Latin America and Europe and declined in the regions of USA, Canada, Asia Pacific, Greater China and Middle East.




Container utilization: Container utilization has declined as compared to last year, in line with the volume.



Note: The Index shows Container utilization (Cbm/TEU) levels rebased as June 2024 = 100


40 feet ratio: 40 feet container ratio remained flat as compared to last year.

FCL operations:

- FCL volume during the month of May 2025 stood at 56,684 TEUs which is similar to last month's volume. As compared to last year volume grew by 6%.
- FCL volume witnessed a year-on-year increase across all major regions.



Air operations:

- Air volume for the month of May 2025 stood at 3,060'000 kilos. This represents a growth of 12% over last month and 4% over last year.
- Air volume witnessed year on year growth in North America, Latin America and Europe. A decline was witnessed in Asia Pacific, Greater China, Middle East and India.
